

INSTRUCTION

6:40 Programs and Curriculum Development

In order to provide instructional services for the students with disabilities of the member districts, the Executive Director, in consultation with the Governing Board, shall develop a plan of programs and curriculum. It shall be a plan that is educationally sound and in accordance with State and federal law and regulations for curriculum and graduation requirements.

The plan shall ensure that member districts have available a full continuum of special education and related services.

The Executive Director shall develop a curriculum review program to monitor the current curriculum and promptly suggest changes to make the curriculum more effective, to take advantage of improved teaching methods and materials, and to be responsive to social change, technological developments, student needs, and community expectations.
